BUSINESS CENTER OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AND EUROPEAN AFFAIRS OF THE SLOVAK REPUBLIC

Business Center is an integral part of the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs of the Slovak Republic representing a separate division under the Ministry's Department–General for Economic Cooperation.

Business Center provides export information and basic consultancy through the 72 bilateral diplomatic missions abroad. It delivers information needed for business activities of Slovak entrepreneurs regarding the export of goods and services, the export of financial capital, the strengthening of existing business cooperation and the establishment of new Slovak firms/enterprises abroad.

It provides support to export investment plans abroad and provides information regarding foreign markets, export opportunities, planned professional and territorial seminars, tenders, business fairs and exhibitions, business missions and forums organized on foreign markets.

The Business Center regularly publishes relevant economic information on the web site Podnikajme v zahraničí (Doing business abroad) as well as a weekly newsletter (also available on the website). It further manages a hotline for the exporters. At the same time, the Business Center cooperates with significant economic institutions (such as the Slovak Chamber of Commerce and Industry, the Slovak Business Agency, the Slovak Investment and Trade Development Agency etc.), prepares materials for the Council of the government of the Slovak Republic for export and investment promotion, prepares economic materials for the Slovak Government, and implements the grant scheme for projects of economic diplomacy.
